He then went on to reprise his role as Gavroche in 2014 on the Broadway stage. Since then, he has taken part in a few off-Broadway shows, such as his originating the role of Young Calogero in A BRONX TALE: The Musical at Papermill Playhouse and playing the lead in YOU'RE A GOOD MAN CHARLIE BROWN at the York Theatre. He also performed at the Hollywood Bowl as Flounder in THE LITTLE MERMAID LIVE IN 2016. Now, Colley is honored to join the STICKS & STONES family and play the part of David in this beautiful show.

MYKAL KILGORE (The Prophet Samuel) appeared in MOTOWN has MUSICAL and HAIR on Broadway, as well as THE BOOK OF MORMON in its first national tour. He has also been seen on NBC's recent live telecasts of Jesus Christ Superstar and The Wiz, and in the 2016 feature film Collateral Beauty. As a member of Postmodern Jukebox, Kilgore has performed with the popular music collective in venues around the world. A singer/songwriter, he has played to many sold-out venues, including the world-famous Apollo's Music Café and the historic Joe's Pub.

GEORGE SALAZAR (King Saul) is best known for originating the role of "Michael Mell" in BE MORE CHILL, for which he won a Lucille Lortel award for Best Featured Actor in a Musical, two Broadway.com audience choice awards, and garnered nominations for Drama Desk and Outer Critics Circle Awards. He received a Drama Desk nomination for his performance in off-Broadway's THE LIGHTNING THIEF: THE PERCY JACKSON MUSIC-AL, in which he played the antithetical roles of "Grover" and "Mr. D." Other credits include Keen Company's Drama Desk- nominated revival of tick, tick... BOOM! and David Byrne's and Fatboy Slim's hit immersive musical, HERE LIES LOVE. George made his Broadway debut singing "Light of the World" in the 2011 Revival of GODSPELL and toured with the second national company of SPRING AWAKENING prior to that. Regional credits include the world premiere of Joe Iconis, Lance Rubin, and Jason

"SweetTooth" Williams' BROADWAY BOUNTY HUNTER, the world premiere of RAGING SKILLET, and THE 25th ANNUAL PUTNAM COUNTY SPELLING BEE. He and collaborator. Joe Iconis. brought their two- man act, "Two-Player Game" to Feinstein's/54 Below in the spring of 2018 for a sold-out seven show run. In 2019 he starred as Seymour in LITTLE SHOP OF HORRORS at the Pasadena Playhouse. George's TV credits include CBS' Bull, HBO's Divorce, and appearances on CBS' LATE SHOW WITH DAVID LETTERMAN, ABC'S THE VIEW, OWN'S THE ROSIE SHOW, and the 2012 TONY AWARDS telecast. Recordings include: GEORGE SALAZAR AND JOE ICONIS: TWO-PLAYER GAME (Ghostlight Records). BE MORE CHILL (Two River & Broadway cast recordings; Ghostlight Records), the Jonathan Larson Project (Ghostlight Records), THE LIGHTNING THIEF (Broadway Records), GODSPELL (Ghostlight Records), BROOKLYN CRUSH (Broadway Records) and MOMENT BY MOMENT, all available on iTunes.

AUDRA McDONALD (*Nizevet*) holds the record for more Tony Best Performance wins than any other actor in history and is the only person to win all four acting categories.

She became a three-time Tony Award winner by the age of 28 for her performances in CAROUSEL, MASTER CLASS, and RAGTIME, placing her alongside Shirley Booth, Gwen Verdon and Zero Mostel by accomplishing this feat within five years. She won her fourth in 2004 for her role in A RAISIN IN THE SUN, a role she reprised for a 2008 television adaptation, earning her a second Emmy Award nomination.

On June 10, 2012, McDonald scored her fifth Tony Award win for her portrayal of Bess in Broadway's THE GERSHWIN'S PORGY AND BESS thus tying a record held by Angela Lansbury and Julie Harris for most Tony Awards won by an actor. In the 2014 Broadway season, she made history by winning her sixth Tony Award for her role as Billie Holiday in LADY DAY AT EMERSON'S BAR AND GRILL.

She also maintains her ties to classical repertoire with an active concert and recording career, performing song cycles and operas as well as concerts throughout the US.

Audra's many television appearances include four seasons as Naomi Bennett in Private Practice, as well as Homicide: Life on the Street, Law & Order: SVU, Having Our Say, Mister Sterling, The Bedford Diaries, Kidnapped, the TV remake of the musical Annie, and HBO's Wit with Emma Thompson and more recently as a cast member of The Good Wife.

In December 2013 Audra won critical acclaim for her performance as the Mother Abbess in NBC's live telecast of *The Sound of Music with Carrie Underwood.* As the host of the PBS series *Live From Lincoln Center*, she won her first Primetime Emmy Award in 2015.

That same year she was named one of Time magazine's 100 most influential people of 2015 and received a 2015 National Medal of Arts - America's highest honor for achievement in the arts - from President Barack Obama.

In 2018, she joined the cast of *The Good Fight* for the second season of the CBS All Access original drama series. Her film roles include *Cradle Will Rock, Object of My Affection, It Runs in the Family, Best Thief in the World,* and *Seven Servants*.

Ms. McDonald returned to the Broadway stage in 2016 with director George C. Wolfe and dancer/choreographer Savion Glover in the musical SHUFFLE ALONG, OR, THE MAKING OF THE MUSICAL SENSATION OF 1921 AND ALL THAT FOLLOWED, a new retelling of an original musical by Eubie Blake and Noble Sissle, for which she was nominated for a Tony Award.

On the concert stage, she has sung with virtually every major American orchestra, and internationally with Théâtre du Châtelet in Paris, as well as with the London Symphony Orchestra and Berlin Philharmonic.

Of Audra McDonald's many roles, she notes that her favorites are the ones performed off stage: passionate advocate for equal rights and homeless youth, wife to actor Will Swenson, and mother to her children.
